SERVICE EVENTS

Our volunteer-based days of service impact the community-at-large, raises awareness for your brand and cultivates relationships within the community. Our events takes place throughout the year and in conjunction with other corporate partners and volunteer groups.

- **All Wrapped Up:** Adopt a family for gift giving during the holiday season
- **Brown Bag Buddies:** Collect kid friendly foods for food insecure children in the summer months
- **Tools for Schools:** Host a school supply drive for low-income students
- **CHEER Yard Clean Up:** Yardwork for our CHEER clients
- **Warm A Heart:** Collect care package items to help our CHEER clients through the colder months
- **Necessities Drive:** Collect items not covered by SNAP (formerly food stamps) for our low income families
- **Game On!:** Create and design games for our young families who are served by our programs

SERVICE PROGRAMS

Employees can volunteer with any of our community programs either administratively or through direct-service.

- **Bergen READS:** Literacy support for students (300 students, 150 volunteers, 9 elementary schools, 30 minutes per student per week)
- **CHEER:** Light errands and visits for homebound seniors (50 clients, 50 volunteers, weekly visits)
- **CHORE:** Home-repairs for seniors and individuals with disabilities (60 clients per week, 3 vans, 5 days a week)
- **Mentoring:** Match youth, seniors, first-generation college students and caregivers with a supportive mentor (50 matches, bi-weekly one-on-one mentoring)
- **Volunteer Income Tax Assistance:** Free tax filing for low-income individuals (250 returns annually)
- **Redefining Retirement:** Helping the newly retired find their 'second act' (quarterly meetings with 40 unique attendees per session)
